What is the London Raiders REP Program

The London Raiders is a Red Circle Hockey Club affiliated program that compete in the Ontario Rep Hockey League (ORHL), a competitive league outside of Hockey Canada's jurisdiction. Players do not require releases from their home teams to tryout. You can come from anywhere.

For those that are offered a position on the team, you will be required to review and return a signed Financial Policy & Code of Conduct Acknowledgement Form and make a **\$300.00 non-refundable deposit** by May 19th to confirm your acceptance.

Spring Hockey Development:

For those that are offered a position on the team or are asked to work on a specific skill over the summer we will be offering a specialized team Hockey Development Clinic with for 6 weeks – Late May until the end of June – **Cost \$190 per player.**

Summer/Fall Skates/Practices

Optional team skates at Summer Pucks pick-up league (approx. \$200 for season)

Warm Up ice on starting in August. Team practices will begin the week of September 4^{th.}

London Raiders, if need be, will hold fall tryouts to fill final rosters the week of Sept 11th

Program Offering:

The ORHL is a cross border hockey league providing a 40-game season consisting of 3 tournaments, 3 showcases and 16 regular season games. In addition to the ORHL schedule the REP teams ages (U9-U17+) are also provided with 2 ice times per week (being a mix of a weekly ice time, dryland training and speciality clinics).

The ORHL does not schedule games during the school week. Should a game be scheduled during the week it would be in close proximity to London.

London Raiders Rep Fee: \$2200.00

The fees for the REP program cover:

- 40 game league schedules (3 tournaments, 3 showcases, 16 regular season games)
- 2 training ice times per week (Team Practice / Hockey Development)
- Home and Away uniforms
- Insurance
- Administrative Costs to run the program.

What is not included in the program fee:

- Hotel fees
- Team clothing

Cost Breakdown (Fees are approximate and based on a team of 16 players):

Ice Costs (player development, ice rental)	1450.00
Insurance & ORHL Membership Fees	225.00
Jerseys, Socks, Bag	225.00
Tournaments & Showcases	200.00
Officials	100.00
Total Program Cost per player based on 16 players per team	2200.00

Sponsorship & Fundraising:

There will be 3-4 fundraising opportunities throughout the season (starting in May) to help reduce your fees. These are selected and run by the Fundraising Coordinator on the Board of Red Circle Hockey Club and will be the same for our Select and REP players.

Each player has the opportunity to secure sponsorship. The first \$200 per player will be allocated to reduce their fees to \$2000. Sponsorship above the \$250 will be allocated by the REP Program Director to provide additional hockey development sessions, use for additional tournaments, or team building events as examples, they will not be used to lower a single players fee. A sponsor of \$2500 or more will have their business name added to a piece of clothing such as the jersey or jacket.

All sponsors will be recognized on the London Raiders REP programs website and team banners.
